Committee members shall consult the appropriate administrative officers and the Campus Planning Committee to inform themselves regarding land use, parking lot design, and landscaping as these considerations bear on campus parking and transportation policies;</p> <p>(b) Advise on plans for campus bicycle traffic;</p> <p>(c) Advise on plans for other modes of transportation, including Cambus;</p> <p>(d) Advise on rules and regulations and fee schedules pertaining to all modes of campus parking and transportation, including priorities, registrations, and penalties for violations;</p> <p>(e) Advise on procedure for handling appeals of fines arising from alleged violations of traffic or parking regulations;</p> <p>(f) Advise in developing and reviewing plans for coordinating University transportation and facilities with those of city, county, state, and federal agencies.</p>
